Director, Policy and Industry Outreach

Brennan serves as the director of policy and industry outreach in the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Industrial Policy, within the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and Sustainment (A&S). Brennan leads all industry engagement for the Under Secretary for A&S, facilitating ongoing and consistent dialogue between the Department of Defense and the industrial base, driving increased collaboration and communication.

As the director for Executive Order 13806, an interagency effort sponsored by the White House Office of Trade and Manufacturing Policy and led by the Department of Defense, Brennan coordinated an interagency team of over 300 subject matter experts to assess the health of the industrial base for current and future operating priorities. She now manages implementation of the risk mitigations and follow-on efforts to determine industrial policy requirements for future acquisition practices within the Department.

Prior to her role in the office of Industrial Policy, Brennan was the program manager of LMI's Research Institute, managing a multi-million dollar research and development (R&D) budget and coordinating over 40 internal and external R&D projects on a variety of technologies. Brennan also supported government clients (NASA; General Services Administration; U.S. Army) in strategic planning, communications, change management, technology transfer and implementation, and workforce development efforts. She served as LMI's additive manufacturing lead, coordinating a number of projects with academic partners and government clients to assess the application of additive manufacturing for repair, production, and counterfeit mitigation.

At Lockton Investment Advisors, Brennan conducted risk management and investment planning for the defined benefit and defined contribution plans of institutional clients. She started her career as a private wealth manager at Morgan Stanley, managing large personal estates, trusts, and retirement plans for high net worth individuals.
